Counseling Center Group Descriptions

Counseling Center Groups are available to community members.

Screening is required--once screened, survivors can come anytime.

Some groups have cycles where clients join on week 1 of the cycle and are encouraged to come for the duration of the group.

"Knowledge is Power" Group - Educational group held with community partners to provide information about a variety of resources available to survivors.

Legal Education (every first Monday)

Staff from Legal Aid Society and Volunteer Legal Services provide information about Family Court, custody and divorce.

Housing Education (every second Monday)

Staff from the Housing Council at PathStone will answer questions and explore options for safe and affordable housing.

Art Group - Art group provides individuals the opportunity to experience all types of art forms with a variety of art materials. Expressing creatively helps individuals understand their thoughts and feelings and promotes self-healing.

Domestic Violence Education - An eight-session interactive series for individuals who have questions about domestic violence and/or individuals who are required to attend a group at Willow Center.

Skills Group - Group held for six weeks which focuses on exploring and building a variety of skills.

Support Group - Discussion group providing a safe and confidential space to discuss a wide range of topics related to domestic violence. Individuals may join at any time.

Seeking Safety Group - Eight week evidence-based skills group focusing on moving beyond domestic violence and increasing personal safety.

Goals to Success Group - Six week group focusing on setting and achieving goals on a path to safety and self sufficiency.
