## **Comprehensive Learning Outcomes:**

- 1. Participants will have a better understanding of and the ability to recognize domestic violence relationship dynamics, including identifying warning signs of a dangerous relationship, abusive tactics, trauma responses and barriers for survivors in domestic violence relationships.
